PREPARATION

- Project brief & campaign pack for each team
- 5 sheets of note paper for each team
- Materials to create campaign posters
- 1 ballot paper for each student
- Certificate

Optional

- Promotional posters and stickers

HOW TO

Make teams of between 5 – 6 students.

Teams begin by assigning roles to each team member as outlined in the project brief.

Next, teams discuss their campaign and decide on 3 campaign promises and a campaign slogan.

It is best to limit the project scope by instructing teams to focus their campaign promises on how to improve life in the classroom, school or local area, etc.

Team members begin writing the speech and creating the poster.

Candidates give their speeches. A space is provided for teams to display their campaign poster during their candidate's speech.

Using the ballot papers students cast their vote. Students are not allowed to vote for their own candidate.

Votes are counted and the winning team is announced.
